This is a very different article than one that I have written previously mainly because of the subject. So let me first address why I am writing on the subject of UFOs!


The secular community will never pass over the opportunity to turn an event or events into the advancement of a godless universe. Regarding this subject they cleverly use half truths leaving the Christian believer wondering... "If there really are UFOs piloted by beings from outer space then that would mean ... (you can fill in the possibilities - Maybe we are not so special; Maybe life did arrive from another planet; If so are they created in the image of God? etc.; etc....?).

Have you wondered about such things?

Some months ago I read a very interesting book entitled "Lights in the Sky & Little Green Men" by Hugh Ross, Kenneth Samples & Mark Clark. Hugh Ross is the founder of Reasons to Believe which is an institute to research and proclaim the factual basis for faith in God and His Word; the Bible. Dr. Ross has a Ph. D. in astronomy. His book came at an opportune time as about a month prior Betty and I watched a 60 Minutes show in which they discussed UFOs and showed some video clips taken by military pilots.

The subtitle of the book is "A Rational Christian Look at UFOs Extraterrestrials." It is comprehensive addressing the subject; not too long (169 pages plus three appendices and notes) and easily understood by laymen (that's me). I'll never do it justice but here are just a few of the topics summary and statements.

First, most UFOs eventually become IFOs (identified flying objects);

about 90% to 95% of the time. Those 5% to 10% of sightings which could not be explained are called residual UFOs or RUFOs. Because these RUFOs lack explanation they are categorized into "two distinct otherworldly hypotheses. One is the extraterrestrial hypothesis which proposes that these are "physical, and empirical realities... piloted by interplanetary space visitors." The other is the

are "physical, and empirical realities... piloted by interplanetary space visitors. " The other is the interdimensional hypothesis which purports that, like the other, these sightings "exhibit physical and empirical effects... but that they are of another realm of reality beyond the time-space continuum." Consequently they are described as the paranormal or occult view of UFOs. In summary these

residual UFOs (RUFOs) are believed to be either travelers from another planet or from another realm beyond our own cosmos.

Dr. Ross then goes into a discussion of the possibility that another planet in the observable universe, other than ours, could support life. After discussing how remote that possibility actually is, he

After discussing how remote that possibility actually is, he summarizes by saying that the possibility of that occurring would be "less than I chance in 10 to the 174th power. How remote is that? To put that number in perspective the number of protons and neurons in the entire universes 10 to the 79th power. That is to say in layman's terms - this little blue sphere on which we live is unique in the cosmos. (If you have ever watched the DVD "The Privileged")

Planet I'm sure you would agree that our planet Earth truly is unique.)

But what about the possibility of life outside of our observable universe? Could aliens travel from those locations?

Because I have to be brief let me just say that we are talking about distances over a quadrillion miles. Travel over such distances at even a small fraction of the speed of light would require many thousands of years. Additionally, Dr. Ross writes that distant travel at the speeds even remotely near the speed of light engender numerous physical obstacles that are impossible to overcome.

But what about the possibility of wormholes where two ends of spacetime (as in black holes) connect to form a tunnel in time? If this could occur then the distance obstacle would not be an impasse. Unfortunately for those holding to this option, it is all speculation. Even if it were possible Dr. Ross writes, any "physical object would be destroyed by the intense gravitational forces in the vicinity of the wormhole."

Dr. Ross then writes about what we do know regarding RUFOs. He says that Jacques Vallee, a computer scientist and astronautical researcher, studied more than 12,000 UFO reports submitted to the US Air Force and found that nearly 3,000 could not be identified as having a human or natural explanation. Dr. Ross then lists fifteen characteristics that seem common to RUFO's. Here are a few examples: They leave no physical artifacts; They may be seen but not photographed as a clear image; They change shape, size, color at random; They constantly succeed in evasion; They physically injure and even kill human observers apart from any identifiable physical agent; etc.

Earlier in this article I mentioned that an alternative possibility of RUFOs is that they come from a different dimension than ours. Dr. Ross says that the most well-known spokesman for this hypothesis holds to the belief in other universes (the multiverse theory). That individual suggests that UFO's most likely originate from other universes.

While Dr. Ross dismisses the multiverse theory, as did Dr. Stephen Meyer in his book "Return of the God Hypothesis" (see October 2022 Joyous News), Dr. Ross writes that before we dismiss any idea Continued on page 4

Continued from page 3 of a reality beyond our own we must not forget that as Christians we too believe in a reality not of this cosmos; heaven

That last sentence is packed with meaning and is a clue as to where Dr. Ross is going in his book. It is evident that he doesn't believe in multiverses but he does believe that this cosmos reveals the handiwork of a Creator who transcends HIS creation; that there is something more than what we can perceive with our senses. (Isn't that what we confess each Sunday in the Nicene Creed? "I believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, visible and invisible.")

It is also evident from what he wrote earlier in the book that he does not believe that the RUFOs (UFOs for which we don't have an answer) are travelers from a distant planet in or outside of our observable universe. So what does he believe about RUFOs?

I will point out a few summary statements from his book each of which Dr. Ross provides supporting

information:

(I) "Residual UFOs are both real and nonphysical...(and) they have an intelligence and a strategic purpose behind them." (2) They "favor certain times and locals." (3) They "seem to have always been around" (4) They "match the scientific literacy of their witnesses" (5) They "make repeat visits to

around." (4) They "match the scientific literacy of their witnesses." (5) They "make repeat visits to certain witnesses and sites." (6) They "visit a select few." (7) They "appear to be alive." (7) They "arouse disturbing emotions." (8) They "cause bodily and psychological harm." (9) They "deceive their human contacts."

With all that Dr. Ross has provided on RUHOs, he then states that "Only one kind of being favors the

dead of night and lonely roads. Only one is real but nonphysical, animate, powerful, deceptive, ubiquitous throughout human history, culture, and geography, and bent on wreaking psychological and physical harm. Only one entity selectively approaches those humans involved in cultic, occult, or New Age activities. It seems apparent that residual UFOs, in one or more ways, must be associated with the activities of demons."

Surprised? I should not have been and neither should anyone else. The reason Dr. Ross offers that we haven't been exposed to this explanation for UFOs is that the truth points to the Christian Bible. The secular world would never admit that the most probable explanation is revealed in the pages of Scripture. The Bible has numerous verses on the activities of angels and demons. Not surprisingly, angels always point us toward God while demons attempt to turn us away.

In closing the Bible reminds us that: "For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places." (Ephesians 6:12) Against such a battle we have a defense: the full armor of God: (Ephesians 6:10-18) Thanks be to God.


